

ARTICLE PUBLICATION GUIDELINES

Articles should meet the requirements presented in the Word style template download available from the website of Educatio journal at:

https://revue-educatio.eu/feuille-de-style-word/

In particular, articles must meet the following requirements:

<u>Article length</u>: No more than 55,000 characters (including spaces) in total, including footnotes, bibliography and annexes.

Component order and format:

- <u>Article title</u> : Times New Roman (TNR) 16 pt, bold, centred
- <u>Article author(s)</u> should be listed as followed : first name(s) last name. Their institutional affiliation should be indicated as a footnote
- French abstract (5 to 8 lines). May be followed by an English abstract
- <u>French keywords</u> (5 to 6 words). May be followed by the corresponding English keywords
- <u>Headings</u>: TNR 13 pt, bold, flush left; TNR 12 pt, bold, flush left for lower order headings
- <u>Body of the article</u>: TNR 12 pt, fully justified, single spacing

Miscellaneous text components:

- <u>Quotations</u>: Roman, preferably between French quotation marks. Short quotations should be included in the body of the text. Long quotations should be presented as a paragraph.
- <u>Notes</u>: Numbered continuously from 1 to n throughout the article and presented as footnotes; TNR 10 pt single spacing
- **<u>References</u>**: Presented as footnotes. Reference details order for books: author(s) ; book title, italicised; publishing location ; publisher ; date ; page(s).
- <u>**Table caption**</u>: to be placed above the table
- Figure caption: to be placed below the figure
- <u>Pictures</u>: accompanied by a caption and copyright information
- Pictures, charts and any visual should be sent as an attached high definition jpeg file

Optional components to be presented at the end of the article

• Annex(es) and/or Bibliography
